Doctor: 'Well, I don't have any medicine for that, so take this \$100.'

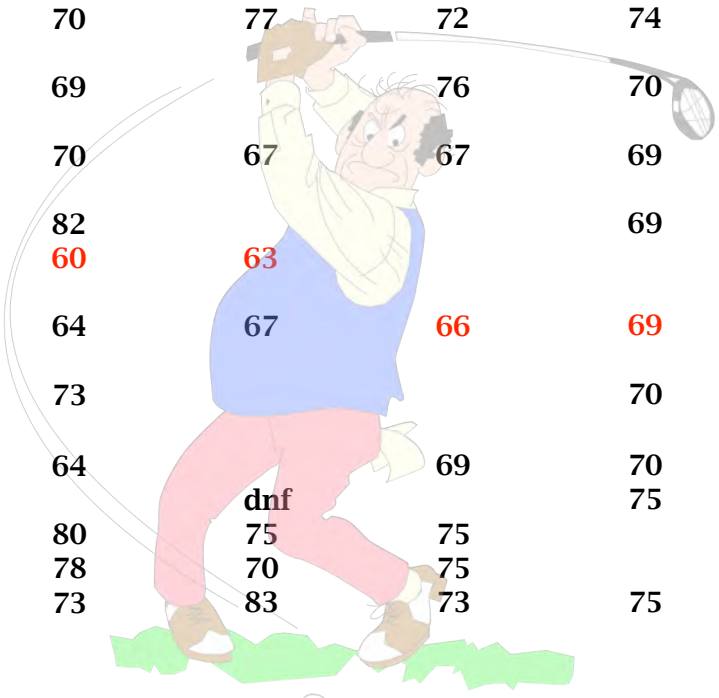
Lawyer (staring at the note): 'But this is \$20, not \$100!!'
