Today's Humor: A panda . . .

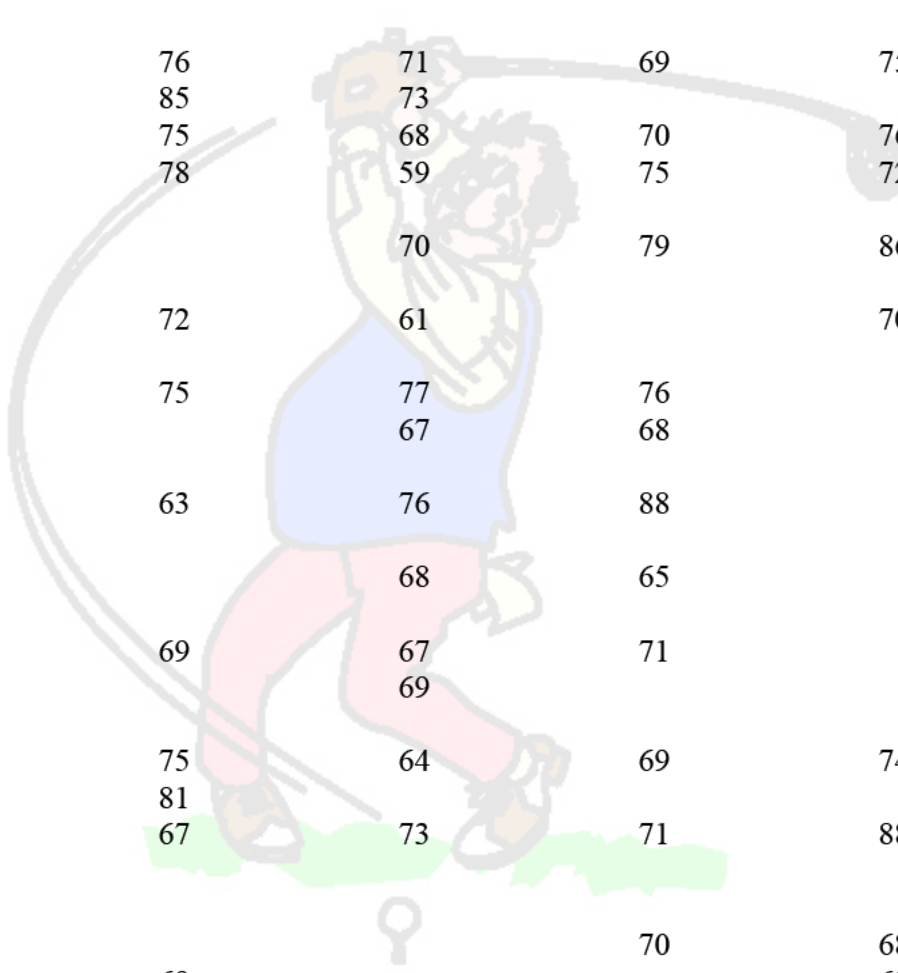
