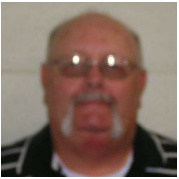

The husband texted back to her:

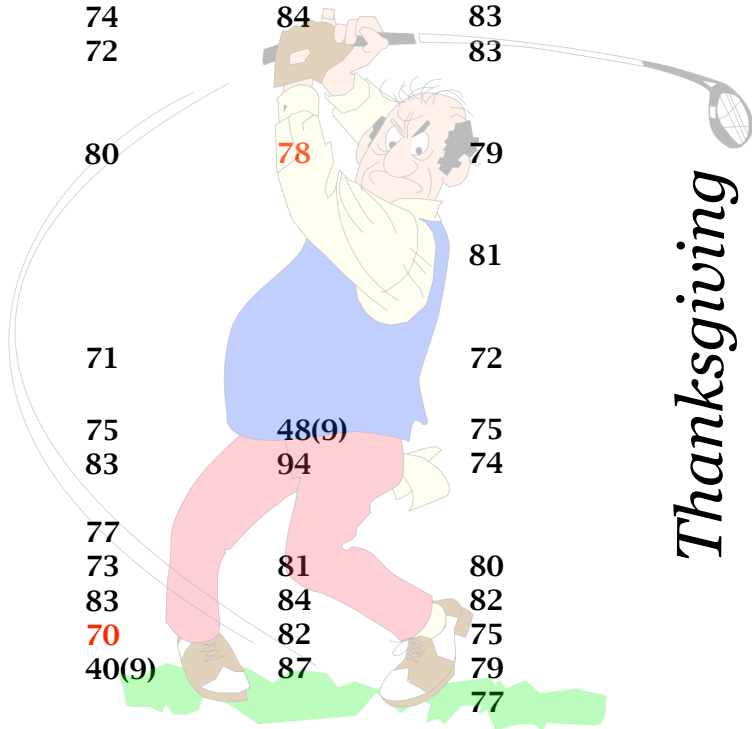
"I'm on the toilet. Please advise."
